It will be seen from this Circular that the College has suffered, along with every other interest, during the progress of the war. The number of students has been diminished to one-third of the usual attendance during the several years immediately previous—the larger portion of the State having been occupied by the Confederate Army at the commencement of the Session in September, 1862, and the College inaccessible in all directions. The regular operations of the Institution, though interrupted occasionally for a few days, have never been suspended. The total loss of time has not exceeded three weeks during the session.

The general demeanor of the students has been exemplary, and nothing has occurred during the session to require the exercise of discipline by the Faculty.

The financial condition of the College, after careful examination by the Board, has been found much better than had been anticipated; and notwithstanding the inevitable diminution of income from every source, it is the purpose of the Board of Trustees and the Faculty to open the Institution regularly on the 14th day of September next.
