Dear Sir:-

The attached bill for services of Mr.

Childs as Coach of the Football Team for the season of 1904, has
been 0 K'd by me to the amount of \$275.00, for the following reasons:

First, The arrangement for the employment of the Coach was made by Dr. Blanton in connection with the athletic committee of the Faculty before my arrival, and was conditioned on the possibility of help from the Board, on the ground of a considerable decrease in the expenditure in connection with the Gymnasium and athletic work of the institution. It was thought possible by this committee that the athletic affairs of the college could be carried without further indebtedness if this much could be appropriated from college funds. This conclusion was arrived at in view of the strenuous efforts made last year for the payment of all indebtedness of the Athletic Association.

Second. There are no funds in the hands of the Arhletic Association to meet this obligation, and the bill must be paid without delay.

Thirs. If this debt was placed on the students themselves, it would result in great discouragement and would engender bad feeling. The students have been loyal, both in the work and support of their football team and in the face of great discouragement, and they deserve recognotion of this at our hands.

Fourth. The income of the Athletic Association this year has been sufficient to meet the necessary expenditure for suits and other expenses of the team, and it is estimated that enough funds are in sight to pay all the expenses of other athletic enterprises during the year without incurring further indebtedness.
