Dear Dr. Montgomery;

Relative to indentity of the Carson-Newman player who was Sigma Chi and claimed to have been captain of the Freshmen team at Ohio State, I have just talked with a local Ohio State student who says that the captain and quarterback of the Ohio State Freshmen team of 1922 was one "Hickey" Freeman, who was also a Sigma Chi and a classmate of my informant.

Freeman was quite a success as a football player but failed in his studies and was dropped. During the following football season, 1923, he was at Ohio Wesleyan but again failed in his studies and is not back with them this season. He was of the usual migratory athlete type and is doubtless the man who showed up at Danville with Carson-Newman.
